1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Nanag Ram S/o Shri Kalyan Singh** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.191/2025 Dated 23.05.2025 registered at P.S. Chaksu District – Jaipur City (South), for the offence under Sections 70(1) and 308(2) of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the

jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for applicant submits that for alleged incident of 17.04.2025, report is registered by a 19 years old victim on 23.05.2025 and thereafter, this victim has appeared before Police Station Chaksu and specifically denied involvement of present applicant. He further submits that the present applicant is called by PS Chaksu on 13.08.2025 and he was illegally detained till his arrest on 17.08.2025. He further submits that the victim was present before a Co-ordinate Bench of this Hon'ble Court on 18.09.2025 and she has specifically reiterated that the present applicant is not involved in the incident. He further referred affidavit filed by victim before the trial Court and submitted that even at the time of consideration of bail by the trial Court, the victim was present and she has again denied role and involvement of the present applicant. He also referred affidavit of mother of victim and submitted that she also denied involvement of the present applicant. He submits that the present applicant accused is falsely implicated by police who is in custody since 17.08.2025.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Considered submissions of Mr. Surendra Singh, ACP Chaksu and Mr. Manohar, SHO PS Shivdaspura and perused the case diary.

6. Learned counsel for the complainant supported the bail application and submitted that he has no objection in case bail is granted to the applicant accused.
7. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
8. The complainant, born in the year 2005, has registered a criminal case by filing a complaint before learned Judicial Magistrate No. 19, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, HQ Chaksu, which was sent for registration of FIR under Section 175(3) of BNSS and on basis of said complaint, an FIR is registered on 23.05.2025. During investigation, the statements of victim were recorded under Sections 180 and 183 of BNSS and further her medical examination was conducted. As per case diary, the petitioner accused was arrested on 17.08.2025 and he is in custody. The recorded date of birth of victim is 10.05.2007 which means the age of victim at the time of incident is between 16 to 18 years.
9. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
10. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Nanag Ram S/o Shri Kalyan Singh**, is hereby

allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

11. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
12. Before parting the order, it is appropriate to consider issue raised by learned counsel for the petitioner-accused for illegal detention of the petitioner accused from 13.08.2025 to 17.08.2025.
13. The counsel for the petitioner is directed to file affidavit of the petitioner accused, if he is released on bail, by Tuesday evening i.e. 23.09.2025.
14. Learned Public Prosecutor is also directed to file affidavit of concerned ACP and also of SHO, Police Station Chaksu about the allegations leveled in application by the petitioner accused. It is also directed that the CCTV footage of the

concerned Police Station shall also be preserved and in no case, shall be deleted without permission of this Court.

15. Office is directed to list the criminal miscellaneous application after disposal of the instant bail application on Wednesday i.e. 24.09.2025.
