1. The present writ petition has been filed with a prayer to direct the respondent Nos.2 & 3 to provide facility of scribe and reasonable accommodation to the petitioner in the forthcoming examination scheduled on 21.09.2025.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner suffers from benchmark disability as evident from disability certificate dated 12.02.2025, which indicates that: the case of the petitioner falls under intellectual disability; the affected part is the brain, as he has been diagnosed with '*Mild IDD*'; and he has 50% disability, which is permanent in nature. He further submits that despite the same, the respondents have not paid any heed to the request of the petitioner to provide a scribe facility. He further submits that time and again, the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment has issued guidelines to provide scribe facilities to persons with disability within the scope of Section 2(s) of the RPwD Act, 2016. He further contended that the Supreme Court in

Gulshan Kumar vs. Institute of Banking Personnel Selection & Ors. (2025 INSC 142), has observed that the principle of reasonable accommodation is central to ensure equality for all persons with disability, and not providing the facility of a scribe and compensatory time constitutes discrimination under the RPwD Act, 2016.

3. Heard.

4. Mr. Rakesh Choudhary, Sr. CGPC, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

5. Mr. Sandeep Maheshwari, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 & 3.

6. Returnable by six weeks.

7. In the meantime, the petitioner is permitted to appear in the examination to be held on 21.09.2025 at the respective centre with a scribe and the respondents are directed to facilitate the same in accordance with law.

8. Respondents are directed to inform the respective authority for making necessary arrangements and compliance.

9. List this matter after six weeks.
