- Sub: Legal Notice for committing contempt of court for Non-Compliance of the order dated 20.08.2025 in DB Civil Writ Petition(PIL) bearing number 6198/2025 Titled As Public Against Corruption, Versus State Of Rajasthan And Others

Dear Sir/Madam,

Under Instructions and on behalf of my client Public Against Corruption, Jaipur, Reg Office 68/27 Pratap Nagar Sanganer Jaipur through its Secretary Shri Vinod Modi do hereby serve upon you this notice under the facts and circumstances mentioned as under:

1. That my aforesaid client filed a DB Civil Writ Petition(PIL) bearing number 6198/2025 Titled As Public Against Corruption, Versus State Of Rajasthan And Others in the matter of huge encroachment on the land acquired by Government Authorities like Rajasthan Housing Board.
2. That the aforesaid DB Civil Writ Petition(PIL) was heard on 20.08.2025 on dated 20.08.2025 and Hon'ble Court passed interim order in presence of counsels of government. The operative portion of the order dated 20.08.2025 is reproduced below:

In view of the above, it is directed that effect and operation of the order dated 12.03.2025 passed by the Government for regularizing illegal colonies set up on the land which was acquired for Rajasthan Housing Board shall remain stayed till the disposal of this PIL.

We also further direct that any encroachments which have been made on the said land, originally acquired for Rajasthan


Housing Board, needs to be demolished and removed and proper action also requires to be taken against the concerned officers who allow such illegal constructions.

- 3 That, against the order dated 20.08.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court, the State of Rajasthan filed a SLP before Hon'ble Supreme Court which was dismissed as withdrawn on dated 17.10.2025.
- 4 That, even after clear order and directions of Hon'ble Court on dated 20.08.2025, you noticees failed to take any action against the encroachers, even process of taking possession of empty land was not started and no action started against the erring officers which is giving chances to land grabbers to again sale purchase of such land which was acquired by Rajasthan Housing Board. The authorities of my client came to know that huge sale purchase of encroached land have been started through the land grabbers.
- 5 That, this way you have not complied with the interim order deliberately and intentionally which is clearly the case of contempt of court.
- 6 That, you are intentionally flouting the order of the Hon'ble Court, and want to show that you are above the law.

It is, therefore, by this notice you are advised to take prompt action to take possession of the empty/unconstructed land of the encroached area which was acquired by Rajasthan Housing Board with immediate process of removal of encroached land and start action against the responsible officers/officials immediate within a period of 7 days of receipt of this notice, failing which my client will initiate contempt proceedings in pursuance of the order dated 20.08.2025 against you including all concerned for which you will be fully responsible for the cost and consequences.
