Order

1. Learned Additional Advocate General submitted a detailed report dated 03.10.2025 projecting the efforts undertaken by the Investigating Agency to trace the corpus. He submits that vide order dated 17.09.2025, this Court had directed the Investigating Agency to intensify the efforts for producing the corpus before this Court. On that day, a detailed report dated 15.09.2025 was submitted before this Court showing the efforts undertaken by the police to trace out the corpus.

2. Today the Investigating Officer Mr.Suraram, Sub Inspector Police Station Pachpadra District Balotara is present before us and presented for perusal another report dated 03.10.2025 showing the efforts undertaken by him to trace out the corpus.

3. It is strange that the report dated 15.09.2025 and 03.10.2025 is verbatim the same. In the report dated 03.10.2025,



the report dated 15.09.2025 has been cut paste, even without changing full stop and comma.

4. This Court is at pains to note that Investigating Agency is trying to play tricks with the Court. Instead of placing the latest and detailed report with respect to the efforts being carried out, the earlier report dated 15.09.2025 had been re-tagged and submitted before this Court, which clearly shows that no efforts have been carried out by the police to trace out the corpus. The action of the police creates serious doubt with respect to the investigation undertaken by the police in the State of Rajasthan for tracing out the corpus.

5. In this view of the matter, we direct the Superintendent of Police, District Balotara to take appropriate action in the matter and to see that competent Officer is posted to investigate the matter in the present case.

6. The Superintendent of Police, Balotara shall appear before this Court on the next date of hearing and file a factual report clearly explaining the efforts genuinely undertaken by the investigating agency for presenting the corpus.

7. The Superintendent of Police is also directed to take appropriate action against the Sub-Inspector, who has filed the report dated 03.10.2025 before this Court.

8. List the matter on 15.10.2025.
