Learned counsel for the petitioner while challenging the order dated 24.12.2025, submits that the respondent – Rajasthan University of Health Sciences (RUHS), has grossly erred by not permitting the petitioner – college to participate in the counseling for the session 2025-26, ignoring the fact that NOC for 60 seats have been granted by the State.

Learned counsel submits that there was no fault on the part of the petitioner and despite having the due NOC, it has been deprived from participation in the counseling.

Learned counsel further placed reliance upon an order dated 10.12.2024, passed by this Court at Principal Seat, Jodhpur in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.19869/2024** filed by the petitioner, wherein directions were issued to the respondents to permit the petitioner to participate in the counseling for B.Sc. Nursing Course.

Taking note of the above, issue notices of the writ petition as well as stay application to the respondents, returnable within four weeks.

In the meanwhile, the respondents are directed to permit the petitioner-college to participate in the counseling for B.Sc. Nursing Course for additional 20 seats for the academic session 2025-26. It goes without saying that the selection of the students shall be on a provisional basis and the said fact of their admission being provisional in nature shall be duly communicated in the letter/order of admission issued to each student.
