**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE ASHOK KUMAR JAIN**

**Order**

**28/01/2026**

1. Instant writ petition is filed by the petitioners not only to claim appointment on the post of Sub-Inspector (AP), Sub-Inspector (IB) Platoon Commander (RAC) pursuant to advertisement dated 05.10.2016 but also to challenge appointment of ineligible private respondents.

2. During course of arguments, it is submitted by the counsel for petitioners that despite the order dated 14.03.2024, the State respondents have not filed an affidavit containing the details of height and chest measurement of the petitioners as well as private



respondents along with details recorded during Physical Standard Test (PST) of petitioners and of private respondents.

3. This Court has passed following order on 14.03.2024:-

*Counsel appearing for the State-respondents is directed to file an affidavit of the Inspector General of Police (Headquarter Recruitment) with the details of the height and chest measurement of the petitioners as well as the private respondents and shall also enclose the details recorded during the Physical Standard Test of both petitioners and of private respondents.  
List this matter on 21.03.2024.*

4. On 21.03.2024, a statement is made on behalf of State respondent that requisite have been filed. On 20.03.2024, affidavit of Shivraj Meena, DIG (Recruitment and Promotion Board) is filed with certificate dated 18.03.2024 issued by Mr. Sachin Mittal, ADGP (Recruitment and Promotion Board).

5. While noticing discrepancies on 08.01.2026, the Court has directed filing of affidavit of IGP (Headquarter Recruitment) as required by this Court on 14.03.2024.

6. On 19.01.2026, it has been submitted by the State respondents that the post of IGP is lying vacant and they have already submitted affidavit of Shivraj Meena, DIG. Having taken note of submission, the State respondents was directed to file on record affidavit of ADGP (Recruitment or Promotion Board).

7. The material on record indicate that Mr. Sachin Mittal, ADGP (Recruitment and Promotion Board) was In-charge when order dated 14.03.2024 was passed by this Court and he has specifically certified that none of the private respondents was allowed relaxation in physical measurement. The details as submitted with certificate of Shivraj Meena in every affidavit indicate that Mr.





Sachin Mittal, ADGP is well aware about the facts, likely to be considered by this Court.

8. The pleadings in the writ petition clearly indicate serious allegations in recruitment process. The veracity of facts as claimed in writ petition requires to be considered by this Court particularly, when a recruitment process of Sub-Inspector of police is under challenge. The compliance of order dated 14.03.2024, is still a serious issue and requires consideration by this Court.

9. Considering the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and in particular, the order dated 14.03.2024, it is directed to that Mr. Sachin Mittal, ADGP shall personally remain present before this Court on 30.01.2026 at 10.30 AM.

10. A copy of this order be sent to the DGP, Rajasthan for compliance.
