UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Petitioner is aggrieved by the interim order dated 13th November, 2025 passed by the Division Bench of the High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jaipur in connection with D.B. Civil Special Appeal (Writ) No. 1311/2025, whereby operation of the order under challenge dated 30th October, 2025 of the Single Judge has been stayed. Consequently, provisional permission granted by the Single Judge while disposing of a

writ petition of the petitioner and other similarly placed aspirants, who were the writ petitioners, to appear in an examination pursuant to a second advertisement has been made inoperative.

2. Such an order appears to have been made by the Division Bench primarily bearing in mind that no date for conducting the examination has been announced.

3. It appears that the examination conducted in 2021 pursuant to the first advertisement, in which the petitioner and other aspirants had appeared, was subjected to challenge by another set of aspirants as writ petitioners. Such challenge having succeeded, an appeal being DB Special Appeal (Writ) No. 1075/2025 has been carried from the order cancelling the examination, and that such appeal is presently being heard by the same Division Bench on day-to-day basis in terms of an order dated 24th September, 2025 passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court while disposing of Special Leave Petition (Civil) No. 27331/2025.

4. In the event DB Special Appeal (Writ) No. 1075/2025 succeeds, there could perhaps be no need for the Division Bench to look into the grievance which has emerged pursuant to the order passed by the Single Judge dated 30th October, 2025.

5. Be that as it may, it would be in the interest of justice if both the appeals, i.e., DB Special Appeal (Writ) No. 1075/2025 and D.B. Special Appeal (Writ) No. 1311/2025 are heard one after the other. Ordered accordingly.

6. We are informed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the examination in pursuance of the second advertisement is due to be conducted in the month of April, 2026.

7. In such view of the matter, it would be desirable if the Division Bench decides the appeals before it prior to 31st March, 2026.
8. All contentions on merits are left open to the petitioner to urge before the Division Bench.
9. The special leave petition is disposed of on the above terms.
10. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
