Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a regular student of Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Smt. Narayani Devi Girls College, Behror, Alwar, Rajasthan – respondent No.3, which is affiliated to Raj Rishi Bhartrihari Matsya University, Alwar – respondent No.1 and having cleared the second year, is presently pursuing her studies of the V – Semester (Third Year of the said course).

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is a sports person, wrestler and is a Ju – Jitsu player and regularly participates in various national level Ju – Jitsu fighting championship organized by various associations and has also won several medals.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that as the petitioner was participating in one such sports event at Jammu, Jammu and Kashmir from 05.01.2026 to 12.01.2026, she was unable to fill up the examination form for the V – Semester examination, the last date of submission of which was

12.01.2026. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it was only on account of her participation in the sports event that she was unable to fill up the form and in case she is not permitted to fill up the form now, she will be deprived of appearing in the examination and that would adversely effect her academic carrier.

Taking note of the above, issue notice to the respondents.

Mr. Vinod Kumar Gupta, Advocate, who normally appears for the respondent No.1 - University is directed to accept notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 and 2.

Notices be filed for the respondent No.3.

As it has been informed that the examination for the subjects in which the petitioner has to appear are to commence from 29.01.2026, respondents No.1 and 2 - University is directed to accept the offline application form of the petitioner and provisionally enroll her for appearing in the B.A. (V - Semester) Examination, 2025-26 commencing from 29.01.2026 (for the petitioner's subject).

It is clarified that the said appearance of the petitioner in the aforementioned examination is provisional in nature and would not construe any right in her favour.

List the matter after two weeks.
