**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE RAVI CHIRANIA****Order****06/02/2026**

1. The instant second bail applications have been filed by the petitioners -Rasid S/o Fajra, Aasif S/o Sahun and Khushi Mohammad S/o Ibbar, arrested in connection with FIR No.383/2025, Police Station Sikari, District Deeg for the offence under Section 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 317(2), 317(4), 317(5), 303(2), 313, 61(2) & 66D B.N.S. 2023.

2. The first bail applications of the petitioners were dismissed by this Court vide order dated 17.12.2025, thereafter the petitioners have preferred the second bail applications.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents and they are young boys of aged about 22, 21 & 21 years respectively. He further submitted that no recovery is required to be made from the petitioners. He further submitted that the petitioners are behind the bars since 31.10.2025 and after conducting the investigation, the police have filed the charge-sheet on 28.01.2026. He further submitted that the offences are triable by Magistrate and trial of the case will take a long time. Therefore, he prayed that the accused petitioners may be enlarged on bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the second bail applications.

5. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the present case, the fact that charge-sheet has been filed by the Investigating Officer and the fact that the petitioners are behind





the bars since 31.10.2025, no recovery is required to be made from the petitioners, the offences are triable by Magistrate and the trial of the case will take a long time. In view of the above without commenting upon the merits or demerits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to grant bail to the accused-petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the second bail applications filed under Section 483 BNSs are allowed and it is directed that accused-petitioners **Rasid S/o Fajra, Aasif S/o Sahun and Khushi Mohammad S/o Ibbar** shall be released on bail in connection with FIR No.383/2025, Police Station Sikari, District Deeg, provided they execute a personal bond in a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- each along with two sound and solvent sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court for their appearance before that Court on each and every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till the completion of the trial. The petitioners are further directed not to take undue advantage of liberty or misuse the liberty. It is made clear that the observation as made by this Court in the bail applications will not affect the trial of the case.

In pursuance of the directions of this Court dated 5th February, 2026, today the following officials, (1) Mr. Bhaskar Sawant, ACS-Home, (2) Mr. Sanjay Agrawal, DG Cyber Crime, Law & Order, (3) Mr. V.K. Singh, ADGP, Cyber Crime, Law and Order, (4) Mr. Vikas Sharma, DIGP, Cyber Crime, (5) Mr. Shantanu K. Singh, DIGP, Cyber Crime, (6) Mr. Ram Kumar Kaswa, ASP, Legal, PHQ, (7) Mr. Suresh Bansal, Law & Secretary, (8) Mr. Pramod Kaushik, DSD, (9) Ms. Anisha Sharma, Addl. Director Prosecution, (10) Mr. Dr. Vishwas Bhardwaj, Asst. Director (FSL), have appeared before





this Court. It is informed to this Court that the directions were issued by this Court in Criminal Miscellaneous Bail Application No. 7940/2025 and another connected matter, vide order dated 27.11.2025, and for compliance of those directions, certain steps have already been taken and they are trying to expedite the process.

This Court noted that in order to comply with the directions, Departments and Agencies are facing certain financial constraints for which necessary correspondence have been made by them with the Finance Department of the Government. It is expected that the Finance Department of the Government shall provide the necessary funds to Home Department & other Departments and Agencies so as to ensure the availability of complete infrastructure, including complete IT infrastructure, software and manpower etc., as required for carrying out the directions issued by this Court vide order dated 27.11.2025.

After hearing the officials present, this Court grants fifteen (15) days' time to file a detailed affidavit, which must specifically indicate the action taken up till now with respect to each direction as issued by this Court, along with the further time required, if any, for compliance.

At this stage, this Court is not inclined to call the Secretary, Finance Department of the Government, however, in case, this Court finds that in order to carry out the directions dated 27.11.2025, the funds have not been provided, then the Secretary (Finance) shall be called in this regard.





It is expected that apart from filing the affidavit to make compliance of the directions in the stipulated timelines and required additional time, the ACS Home and DG Cyber and other officials of Prosecution and FSL Department shall also utilize their good offices to have a complete ecosystem for effectively dealing with cyber crimes in the State.
