By way of filing the present writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:-

"It is, therefore, most humbly and respectfully prayed that this petition for writ may kindly be allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction:

a) That by an appropriate writ, order or direction, the office order dated 27.03.2026 (Annexure/5), the office order dated 17.04.2026 (Annexure/6) and office order dated 20.04.2026 (Annexure/7) may kindly be quashed and set aside qua the petitioner.

b) That by an appropriate writ, order or direction, the petitioner may kindly be permitted to continue her original place of posting.

c) That any other appropriate writ, order or direction, which is considered just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner to do the complete justice with the petitioner.

d) That the Writ Petition may kindly be allowed with cost."

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner who is a woman employee of the respondent -



department has been transferred more than 500 kms. away from her native place (Udaipur) which has adversely affected her and her family life.

3. Learned counsel submitted that ordinarily, woman candidates should not be transferred at the places which are far away from their native places so as to cause minimum inconvenience to them and their family members. Learned counsel thus prayed that impugned transfer order dated 27.03.2023 (Annexure-5) whereby the petitioner has been transferred to the office of Deputy Director Animal Husbandry Department, Alwar may be stayed.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and having perused the impugned transfer order so also relieving order, this Court does not find the impugned orders to be in violation of any statutory provision or being passed in a mala fide and arbitrary exercise of power. However, this Court keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a woman employee of the respondent department who has been transferred more than 500 kms. away from her native place (Udaipur), this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the petitioner to file a detailed representation before the competent authority of the respondent department ventilating her grievances against the impugned transfer order within a period of 15 days from today.

5. In case, a representation is so made/filed before the competent authority of the respondent department shall consider and decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 60 days thereafter.





6. It is made clear that the aforesaid direction to decide the petitioner's representation has been issued only with a view to expedite/ensure the redressal of the petitioner's grievances and the same may not be construed to an order to decide the petitioner's representation in a particular manner.

7. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
