1. Instant criminal misc. interim bail application has been filed by the petitioner -Sahid S/o Jahir, aged About 18 Years, arrested in connection with FIR No.78/2026, Police Station Kaithwara, District Deeg for the offence under Sections 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 61(2)(a) of B.N.S., 2023 and 66D of I.T. Act.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a student of B.A. Semester III at college Janak Nemsingh Parmar Mahavidyalaya Jaishri Road, Sikri Tehsil Nagar District Deeg, Rajasthan. He further submits that petitioner has filed this interim bail application on the ground that examination for the said course is to commence on 18.06.2026 and the last exam is to be held on 01.07.2026. Learned counsel submits that the

petitioner had secure good marks in the previous semester and intends to pursue his studies. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner prayed that petitioner be enlarged on bail.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor strongly opposed the interim bail application.

4. Considering the nature of allegation and the fact that the petitioner is a student, this Court deems it appropriate to grant 45 days interim bail to the petitioner for the period from 16.06.2026 to 02.07.2026.

5. Accordingly, the instant bail (interim) application is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner shall be released on interim bail for a period from 16.06.2026 to 02.07.2026, provided he shall surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent on 02.07.2026 with further condition that he shall furnish a sum of Rs. **50,000/-** before the trial Court and furnish a personal bond in a sum of Rs. **1,00,000/-** with two sound and solvent sureties in the sum of Rs. **50,000/-** each to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court for his surrender on 02.07.2026. It is also ordered that one of surety to be furnished by a close relative of petitioner.

6. Pending application(s), if any also stands disposed of.
