Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that, after following due process of law, the petitioner(s) has/have established a duly compliant Assisted Reproductive Technology (ART) Clinic (Level-II) operating under the name of 'Kanha IVF



Hospital' at Near Orbit 2 Apartment, New Bhupalpura, Udiapur, Rajasthan. Learned counsel submits that, after establishing the aforesaid IVF Centre, the petitioner(s) applied for registration thereof before respondent No.5, namely, the State Assisted Reproductive Technology and Surrogacy Board, Jaipur, Rajasthan, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 15 and 16 of the Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Act, 2021. It is submitted that the application dated 06.06.2025 (Annexure-2) submitted by the petitioner(s) seeking registration of the aforesaid IVF Centre has not yet been decided by respondent No.5, without there being any valid reason or justification for the delay.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner(s) and having perused the provisions of Sections 15 and 16 of the Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Act, 2021, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the competent authority of the State Assisted Reproductive Technology and Surrogacy Board, Jaipur, Rajasthan, to consider and decide the application dated 06.06.2025 (Annexure-2) submitted by the petitioner(s) seeking registration of its aforesaid IVF Centre, strictly in accordance with law, within a period of ten days from the date of submission of a certified copy of this order.

The stay application also stands disposed of.
